Forklift Training Tips

The following checklist is essential for any workplace that has lift trucks on the premises. Each of these questions must be answered with "yes" if all the safety rules and regulations are being followed. A "no" to whichever question indicates a procedural weakness which may result in damage to machine, accident or injury.

- 1) Is the traffic of the pedestrians separate from the operating area of the forklift?
- 2) Is pedestrian access to travel areas of the forklift restricted by barriers?
- 3) The walkways for pedestrians are well-marked?
- 4) A sign is visibly clear stating a "forklift in operation"?
- 5) There are mirrors provided at blind spots for operators and pedestrians?
- 6) Changes or alterations to the daily forklift schedule has been communicated to employees?
- 7) The forklift tires being utilized are suitable for all operating surfaces?
- 8) Is the seatbelt being used?
- 9) Is the seat in good condition?
- 10) Is a regular forklift maintenance schedule adhered to?
- 11) Are annual inspections of the forklift being done?
- 12) Is the forklift right for the needed job?
- 13) Does forklift has a readable load chart?
- 14) Can the operators read and understand the load chart?
- 15) Does the chart list the safe capacity for various uses and attachments?
- 16) Do the forklift warning devices work right?
- 17) The speed operating control device is secured properly?
- 18) Is overhead cage fitted right on the forklift?
- 19) Have all forklift operators obtained certification?
- 20) Are speed limits and warning signs being observed?
- 21) Are lift truck operators up to date on training for all kinds of forklifts being utilized?
- 22) Do operators know their responsibilities to report any machine damage and forklift incidents?
- 23) Is the pre-test checklist reviewed each and every day prior to the machinery being used?
