There are numerous ways to go about getting Loader Training. Courses are provided through company forklift certification programs, workforce training agencies, and approved video and online courses. The cost can be minimal (or free of charge) when offered by occupational safety officers on job sites or through employment agencies.

In nearly all countries, forklift operators are needed to be over the age of 18 years old. Local industry bodies together with federal and local authorities can approve the Loader Training programs. They require that operators acquire lift truck certification before utilizing a forklift machinery. A certificate is valid for four years in most areas. Companies that hire workers to drive lift truck trucks can face serious liability issues if operators fail to keep this certificate up to date.

The untrained forklift operator is more at risk to lead to damage or injuries due to improper utilization of the lift truck. Thus, safety training courses will include correct techniques for loading and driving. Workers must pass a written test to be able to be certified. A business would usually designate a supervisor to provide hands-on training to new staff. A certified supervisor must have extensive training in lift truck safety and be licensed as a trainer.
